Often, when we think about belonging, we associate it with our country of birth, or the country we are raised in. This stems from the common belief that the place of one's origin is the place one should know best. However, this easy version of belonging is complicated by increasing rates of global migration. Growing up, she has travelled between Malaysia and China while being educated at an American international school.
